SAFETY

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL DIVISIONS.

- 1) Full face helmet or moto-type helmet with goggles and gloves. 2005 Snell or newer.
- 2) Full length sleeves and pants must be worn at all times while riding. At no time will any rider be permitted onto the racetrack without proper riding gear.
- 3) A riding boot or heavy duty-toe boot is required. 3) **No tennis or sneaker type shoes allowed.**
- 4) All headlights and taillights must be removed, disconnected, or taped up completely. No light may shine through.
- 5) All bikes must go through and pass pre-race tech 2) inspection. 3)
- 6) All bikes must have clearly marked number plates on front and sides. Dark numbers on white plates preferred.

65CC AND UNDER/110CC AND UNDER

- 1) 65cc and Under: 65cc engines and under
- 2) 65cc and Under: Ages 5-12 ONLY.
- 3) 2 stroke engines are approved
- 4) Knobbie tires are approved.

KIDS 85 CC/150 CC

- 1) 85cc, 2 stroke engines only
- 2) All riders must be 13 years and younger
- 3) Class C and knobbie tires are approved

PIT BIKES

- 1) 2 valve, 150cc and under, air cooled, 4 stroke engines only.
- 2) 14" front and 12" rear maximum tire size

500CC VINTAGE/750CC VINTAGE

- 1) Pre-1975 bikes ONLY
- 2) Class C tires ONLY.
- 3) 500cc Vintage: 500cc engines and under
- 4) 750cc Vintage: 750cc engines and under

VINTAGE VET 35 plus

- 1) Open engine size and bike
- 2) Only riders age 35 and older are approved
- 3) Class C tires ONLY

VINTAGE VET 50 plus

- 1) Open engine size and bike
- 2) Only riders age 50 and older are approved
- 3) Class C tires ONLY

HARLEY HOOLIGAN

- 1) Open engine size and bike
- 2) Open tire compound and size
- Ventura Raceway safety rules must be adhered to and will be strictly enforced.

250CC MOTOCROSS FLAT TRACK/250CC MOTOCROSS

- 1) 250cc, 4 stroke engines and under.
- 2) 125cc, 2 stroke bikes are approved
- 3) Motocross-type bikes only
- 4) **For the Flat Track division**, knobbies are the only approved tire. Class C tires are not approved.

450CC MOTOCROSS FLAT TRACK/450CC MOTOCROSS

- 1) 450cc, 4 stroke engines and under.
- 2) 250cc, 2 stroke engines are approved.
- 3) Motocross-type bikes only
- 4) **For the Flat Track division**, Knobbies are the only approved tire. Class C tires are not approved.

PRO/AMATEUR MODERN OPEN

- 1) Open engine size
- 2) Open chassis
- 3) Class C tires are the only approved tire type
- 4) A rider may <u>not</u> compete in both the Pro Modern Open and Amateur Modern Open

<u>DUE TO RISING INSURANCE COSTS AND NUMEROUS CLAIMS DURING MOTORCYCLE EVENTS, FOR THIS</u> EVENT THERE WILL BE NO PARTICIPANT ACCIDENT COVERAGE.

Riders may no longer compete in both the Pro Modern Open and the Amateur Modern Open. A rider must choose one class and will not be permitted to change classes after 2:30

A full face helmet or moto helmet with goggles must be worn at all times on the racetrack. This rule will be strictly enforced beginning at this event

Please note the new pre-entry fee pricing. \$45 for one class or \$35 each if you are riding 2 or more classes

2015 VENTURA RACEWAY MOTORCYCLE RULES

GENERAL RULES

- 1) Number plates are mandatory. The recommended size of the plates are 10" x 12" with a black number on a white background. Any bikes running without number plates may not be scored and may not be eligible for a finish.
- 2) All vehicles must pass pre-race safety inspection before going onto the track.
- Riding and or warming up vehicles in the pit or parking areas is not permitted at any time. Riding is only permitted at a slow speed when going to and from the tech line and staging.
- 4) Corner yellows will be used. When you are entering an area of the track under a yellow, you may not pass. Any passing under a corner yellow will result in a 2 position penalty. When a yellow flag or red flag is displayed at the start/finish line, the field is expected to slow or stop, when safe to do so.
- 5) Cutting the course in any manner including racing on the infield by flat track divisions or bypassing jumps by motocross divisions will result in a one position penalty
- 6) Each motorcycle division will have a maximum of 6 bikes per row in the starting grid. Each quad division will have a maximum of 5 quads per row in the starting grid.
- 7) For divisions with 14 bikes or less, one heat race will be run. 15 bikes or more, two heat races will be run. The finishing order of the heat races will determine the feature starting lineup.
- 8) In the event of short fields, comparable divisions may be combined into one event but will be scored separately
- 9) All riders must be in staging at the appropriate time for their event. Please pay attention to pit announcements and watch for the signs posted in the staging area for your race. Once re-entry is closed, riders will not be permitted to join the event under any circumstances.
- 10) All riders must be 14 years or older to be eligible for competition in all divisions with the exception of the 65cc and Under division, the 110cc and Under division. For the Road Course and Flat Track Quad divisions all riders must be 16 years and older.
- 11) You will not be permitted to ride in any event that has not been indicated on your tech sticker.
- 12) If you are injured during the event, please ensure an accident report is filled out by a track staff member. Ventura Raceway will not be held responsible for any injuries that are not reported the night of the event
- 13) Two-way radio communication is not permitted at anytime.
- 14) With the exception of Pro Modern Open and the Flat Track Quads, the division's heat race(s) are lined up by the order of entries received. The feature is lined up by the finishing positions of the heat race(s)
- 15) The Pro Modern Open and Flat Track Quads heat race(s) are lined up by a blind pill draw. The feature is lined up by the finishing positions of the heat race(s)
- 16) No recording devices of any kind may be mounted to riders helmet.
